WOMEN'S CARE PROGRAMS

WITH MOTHER'S DAY JUST AROUND THE CORNER, CAMO is celebrating the women of Honduras, who do so much to support their families and help their children achieve bright futures. Maria Francisca Chavez, one of the patients visiting CAMO's Cervical Cancer program at the Health Center of Santa Rosa de Copan, is 56 and a single mother of four children. With her came five other women, all from the rural community of Capucas, San Pedro Copán, and all needing immediate medical treatment.

These women have been suffering silently, not recognizing the symptoms of cervical intraepithelial neoplasia (CIN) in their bodies; they only learned that they needed treatment through our recent medical brigades to rural areas, when CAMO staff worked to raise awareness of cervical and breast cancer prevention and provided cytology screening and other services to 410 women. Sadly, biopsies revealed that twenty of these women, including Maria Francisca and her companions, had cancerous lesions needing urgent medical treatment.

These mothers want to watch their children's soccer games, watch them grow up, celebrate their high school graduation. Through our program, they have that chance: women whose screenings reveal anomalies are sent to CAMO's clinic in Santa Rosa de Copan for crucial services, including x-ray exams, mammograms, ultrasounds, cervical cancer screening, and follow-up treatment.

Without our help, rural women in Honduras cannot access these lifesaving interventions. They have faith in us. We, too, have faith: in the generous support of you, our donors. With your support, CAMO is able to screen a few more women, provide a few more treatments, save a few more lives every year. Help each of these women celebrate another Mother's Day with their children. Together we can do so much more for women and children in Honduras. One colposcopy is only \$40.54, one cryotherapy is only \$54.05—and this small sum can save a life.
