## Provide Capital Improvement Funds

### Community Development

#### PROJECTS

Suggested \$50,000

CAMO education, support and social services develop good citizens, combat crime and fear and promote security and well-being. These infrastructures have made Santa Rosa the safest city – but capital improvements and expansion are required.

- Building a new dormitory at the Trade School will allow rural students to get marketable job skills. Many rural families live off the land and have no money to send their children anywhere for education, much less house them. We are currently expanding the school to provide housing for these rural students to get training to meet the demands of the labor force (unemployment rate is 63%). Annually, 600 teenagers ages 13-18 years old complete programs in welding, carpentry, computer and culinary. (Need for completion is \$400,000)
- Expanding the Boys/Girls Club will create a youth mentoring center for at-risk youth. More classrooms will allow increased character development and after-school programming -building resilience to avoid a life of crime. The Community Recreation Center serves 300/day and 1000/weekend (only gym for 1 million people) with transportation from schools, intramurals, weight room and aerobic classes. (Need for completion is \$150,000)

### Expansion of CAMO Honduras Facility

#### PROJECTS:

Need: \$175,000

Two acres of land in Santa Rosa has been donated to CAMO. We are in the process of designing a new warehouse facility on this land and then remodeling our present facility to provide medicals service within our existing facility which is across from the Hospital.

Phase one will be the building of warehouse on the land donated. This basic structure will cost approximately \$175,000.

Need: \$250,000

Upon completion of phase one, phase two will be undertaken. This includes the present 20 feet high warehouse space will be converted into two stories where patient services will be offered. This area will become the new Prosthetic Lab and Dental clinics, dermatology, neurology, ophthalmology clinics, OB/GYN to name a few. Estimated cost of this will be \$250,000.
