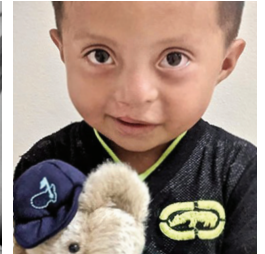

A REST FOR HER SHOULDERS OFFERS REST FOR HER SOUL

FOR CAMO STAFF, IT'S IMPOSSIBLE TO FORGET OUR VERY FIRST ENCOUNTER WITH MARIA BERNARDA. She stumbled into the clinic with a heavy bag across one shoulder and a tiny twelve year old girl, Nelly Ruby, in her arms. Nelly had just been just discharged from the Hospital de Occidente—but Maria knew she needed follow-up care. So she came to CAMO to meet with our nutritionist, Bianca Ramirez. After evaluating Nelly, Bianca realized that the child was severely malnourished and urgently needed nutritional treatment.

Born with cerebral palsy, Nelly was left alone in the world when her mother died. Maria took Nelly in to raise as her own, despite Nelly's delicate health and Maria's difficult economic circumstances. It's hard to imagine the day-to-day challenges Maria faced as a single mother in an underdeveloped country like Honduras, with no assistance from the government. With no wheelchair, she carried Nelly everywhere for twelve years.

Thankfully, CAMO's medical programs provided Nelly and Maria with nutritional care, a wheelchair and other essential medical supplies. We gave Maria a chance to rest her shoulders... which also provided a rest for her soul. A simple wheelchair may not seem like much, but to Maria and Nelly, it is everything.

Thinking about Maria Bernarda's story, we ask ourselves, "how many more women and men are like Maria, living a life of service to others but struggling against limitations? How can we support them with the resources we have?" CAMO's doors are open for them. Are yours?
