SINCE MARCH 2020, MANY OF CAMO'S INCOME GENERATING PROGRAMS HAVE BEEN SHUT DOWN BECAUSE THEY WERE NOT DIRECTLY TREATING COVID-19. WE'RE FUNDRAISING TO MAKE UP FOR THEIR LOSS.

PROSTHETIC/ORTHOTIC

We have been able to treat 47 patients since opening this summer.

SCREENING AND TREATMENT CENTER FOR CERVIX CANCER

25 women per month were treated for cancerous lesions on their cervix before COVID-19. Now, up to 25 women per month may perish if we cannot open the Center for screening & treatment.

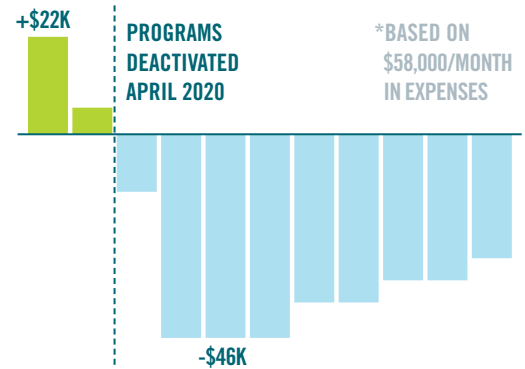
OPHTHALMOLOGY

On June 8th the Ophthalmology, Orthotics, and Prosthetics programs were moved to the new eye facility. These two services are seeing patients daily in increasing numbers as these programs are reactivated.

PROJECTED DEFICIT BY END OF YEAR: **-\$178,000**

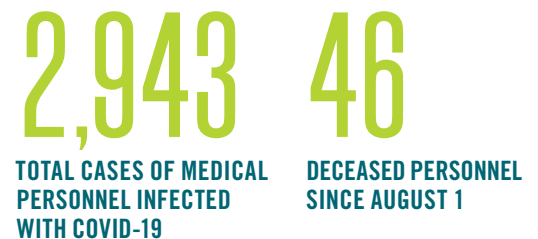


BEDS PER 10,000 PEOPLE COMPARED TO USA
