After a life in darkness, sight and hope is restored

Juan, a 23-year-old painter and farmer, struggled with vision problems since childhood. Without being seen by a doctor, his vision deteriorated, causing partial closure of one of his eyes and imminent blindness. Upon learning about CAMO through a friend, Juan sought help and was diagnosed with congenital cataracts in both eyes. Our dedicated doctors at the Robles Eye Center performed the crucial surgery, a success that restored Juan's ability to farm and paint. Now, he even sees colors with new clarity! Eight months after his surgeries, Juan is picking coffee beans on their farm, an activity that generates income for him and his family.
