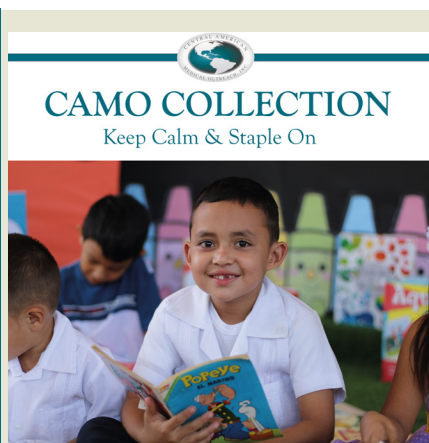

Community Gym: A Legacy of Dedication and Hope

For the past 28 years, Marvin has been the heartbeat of our community gym in Santa Rosa de Copan, Honduras. More than just a coach, he is a mentor, role model, and friend—devoting his life not only to teaching volleyball and basketball but to shaping young lives through the values of respect, honesty, discipline, perseverance, and a deep love for God.

"I've dedicated my life to the gym," Marvin shares with a cheerful smile. And he truly has.

Several years ago, Marvin was diagnosed with kidney failure. Twice a week, he endures a grueling 2–4 hour journey to San Pedro Sula for dialysis. Yet every afternoon, he returns to the gym—smiling and fully present—ready to coach the next generation with joy and passion.

"I believe God has a very clear purpose for me. I am His instrument. I strive to do positive things and leave a mark on our children and youth," Marvin says. One story speaks volumes about Marvin's compassion. He shares, "Recently three siblings enrolled at the gym, but only one showed up each day. I asked why they didn't come together and the child quietly explained that they shared a single pair of gym shoes. 'That broke my heart, so I went out and bought three pairs so they could come together.'"

Today, between 400 and 600 children and youth pass through our gym doors daily—participating in table tennis, chess, volleyball, soccer, basketball, and weight training. These opportunities foster not only athletic growth but also community, mentorship, and hope.

This June and July, our CAMO Collection Campaign is supporting the gym by providing jerseys, shoes, cleats, and recreational equipment.
