Since the donation of six NICU incubators from Salem, Oregon in February, the infant mortality rate in Gracias, Honduras has dropped from 22% to 7.7%. A Timely Answer to Prayer



When the fire department in Santa Rosa de Copán-serving over 70,000 people-reached out to CAMO needing a Jaws of Life rescue equipment, we searched everywhere with no success. Eventually, we turned to prayer, trusting God to provide. Six months later, during a meeting with an insurance agent, our Assistant Director, Rachel Foltz, was asked, "What does CAMO need?" She shared the firefighters' request, and the man replied, "I think I know someone." Within the hour, Citizens First Fire Training offered to donate the exact tools needed! Even better, three firefighters from New Philadelphia, OH committed to travel to Honduras to personally train the local department. God provides, often in the most unexpected ways, but always right on time.



The community gym in Santa Rosa de Copán serves 400–600 people every day. After years of heavy use, the gym coach reached out requesting new weightlifting equipment to keep up with growing demand. We prayed for three months, asking God to meet this need. A company from Cleveland reached out to us and generously donated seven gym-grade machines—including ellipticals, treadmills, and weight equipment. The donation has already arrived in Honduras and is used daily by the community.

Another reminder that faithful prayer leads to faithful provision.
