## A Fragile Beginning — A Chance for Hope

When a six-month-old baby arrived weighing only four pounds and struggling with a respiratory infection, our medical team knew something was terribly wrong. Ana had come for plastic surgery to repair her cleft lip and palate—but she was far too weak for surgery.

Her mother, Rosa, a timid indigenous woman, held fragile little Ana tightly in her arms. She had traveled 12 hours hoping someone could help her baby. Doctors quickly discovered that Ana was suffering from severe malnutrition, pneumonia, and anemia.

Convincing Rosa to admit her tiny daughter to the hospital was not easy. For eight difficult days, Ana fought to regain strength. When she was finally stable enough to leave the hospital, a new journey began.

CAMO's Nutrition Program stepped in.

Nutritionist Bianca Ramírez, alongside program champions Dr. Joe and Dr. Deb Marino, and CAMO counterpart Dr. Javier Pérez, began working with Rosa. Ana received medical treatment, nutrition therapy, food support, and a safe place to stay at CAMO's Women's Shelter while her family faced a serious food crisis. Slowly, Ana began to grow stronger. With continued care, she now has the chance to gain enough strength to receive her life-changing surgery this August. Sadly, Ana's story is not unusual. For the past 10 years, CAMO's Nutrition Program has been responding to these heartbreaking realities.

"Time and again we witness individuals and families recovering from crisis through nutritional support," share Dr. Joe and Dr. Deb Marino. "Through your generosity, children and adults find health and hope for their future." Over the past decade, CAMO's Nutrition Program has provided more than 33,600 nutritional consultations and treatments to vulnerable individuals.
